Cricket- To practice bowling, batting, catching and fielding skills. To understand the rules of a game progressively. **My Happy Minds-** Looking at the brain and how it works.


Introducing 'Team HAP'- the hippocampus, amygdala and prefrontal cortex. Understanding how our brain grows using neural pathways and neuroplasticity.




Humanities


Tudors- Looking at the timeline and important figures and events during the Tudor time period, such as Henry VIII, the Spanish Armada and The Battle of Bosworth. Investigate Tudor life- the way they dressed, what they ate, the way they lived and their past times. A comparison between the rich and poor.

Wrexham - Where in the world is Wrexham? Looking at world maps, atlases and Google Earth. What is there to do in Wrexham? How is land used in Wrexham? Identify the human and physical features of Wrexham and how it has changed over time.

Pollution - What are different types of pollution? What is in your rubbish? Identifying household rubbish and patterns and trends in recycling. Conducting an investigation into separating household rubbish using water and magnetism. Looking at litter pollution and landfill sites.

Light- Identifying sources of light. Investigation transparent, opaque and translucent materials. How does light travels? Inevstigate shadows- how can you change the size of a shadow? Looking at light in relation to night and day.

ICT-Introducing the children to Google Classroom. How to log in, how to hand in and access work, how to add pictures, how to edit and upload files. How to stay safe online, thinking about public profiles, passwords, cyberbullying, reporting and plagiarism. Looking at creating presentations using PowerPoint/Slides. How to make information engaging using colour, animation, font and pictures.
