A HUGE thank you to everyone who donated.



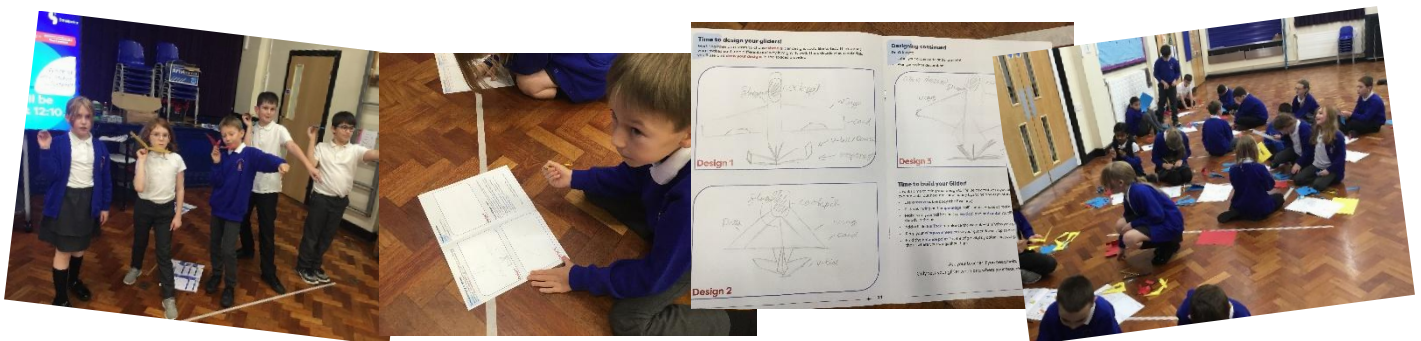
A visit from Herbet.
