Expressive Arts

For our art this topic we will look at the people of the rainforest. In particular Indigenous art and its origins, how it is used to show identity, cloth design, bead design and mask making using clay techniques (scoring, shaping, attaching).

The global issue of deforestation will be looked at in this topic- where they are, issues in the wider world, why are they changing, causes and consequences, effects people have, features, weather (data), sustainability and fact and opinion.

My Happy Mind- Engage, this module looks at re-capping all the things the children have learnt for far this year and how they can be put into practical goals.

Orienteering- We will look at orientation of maps, how to read them, spotting symbols and taking part in orienteering challenges. With Sports Day during this term we will be practicing all the skills needed as well as competing to find sets of children to represent their houses on the day.



Science and Technology

We will be looking at animals and their habitats. We will explore what makes a habitat, who lives where, how branching keys are used, adaptations animals have to make in the wild and life cycles.

We will look at data handling tools, we will learn how to navigate them, as well as add and adapt online databases for information handling.



Languages, Literacy and Communication

Children will look at the book 'Killer Cats and Habitats' written by Anne Fine. They will use this to create their own chapters based on the authors witty diary style.

Children will be writing a non-chronological report based around animals they have learnt about in science.

Children will look at the use of persuasive language to write letters about deforestation and what we can do to protect the rainforests. They will also look at how to organise a debate around the same topic.
