## Expressive Arts

**Art:** Children will be choosing, using and mixing their own colour to create pieces of art. They will explore the life and work of 6 key abstract artists and create a range of pieces.



## Humanities

This term we will be learning all about Wales and Wrecham. Pupils will be leading their learning through identifying what they want to know about Wales and their local area. Along side leading their own learning they will be learning valuable skills.

During the Autumn term will focus on Christianity and The Nativity Story.

## Health and Wellbeing

**Happy Minds:** Looking at the brain and how it works. Introducing 'Team HAP' - the hippocampus, amygdala and prefrontal cortex. Understanding how our brain grows using neural pathways and neuroplasticity.

**Circuit Training:** Children are to complete different exercises discussing how their body feels whilst exercising, identifying which muscles they are working, discussing how repeating the exercises weekly can improve their performance and creating their own exercises to improve general fitness.

**Safety-** Children will consider what it means to take responsibility for their own safety. This will include the decisions they make and how they can stand up to peer pressure in a range of situations. They will learn about everyday risks, hazards and dangers and what to do in risky or dangerous situations. They will also learn about road, water and rail safety and dangerous substances: drugs (medicines), cigarettes and alcohol. Children will look at first aid, exploring how to deal with common injuries and what to do to respond to emergency situations.

## Science and Technology

**Human Body** – Looking at naming and locating organs, bones and muscle and describing their role in the human body. Children will be carrying out investigations to answer questions as well as understanding how to ensure their investigations are fair.

**Healthy Smoothies** – Children will investigate the main ingredients in drinks and will look at labels to discover sugar content to decide how healthy the drink is. They will try different drinks to identify personal preferences and explore mixing ingredients to discover what tastes nice. They will then use what they have learnt to make their own healthy smoothie and write a set of instructions so others can also make it.

**ICT** – Children will be learning about internet safety and basic skills do do with Google Classroom, HWB and Word.



## Languages, Literacy and Communication

**George's Marvellous Medicine** - Looking at character descriptions and the vocabulary and features needed to make them exciting, such as adjectives, adverbs, similes ad verbs. Poetry including alliteration, onomatopoeias, rhyme and calligrams.

**Poetry – Gran Can You Rap** – Looking at what makes a good performance such as volume, rhythm, expressions, actions, eye contact, tempo and then using this to perform a rap poem.

**Instructional Writing** - Looking at the different types of instructions, why we need them, the importance of following them carefully and why it is important to add the correct detail. Children will learn about imperative verbs and what features are needed to write their own set of instructions.
