Expressive Arts

The children will learn dance through character looking at different shapes, movement and levels.

Whilst studying the Celts and the Romans children will experiment with colours, shapes and patterns to create their own mosaics. They will be using what they have learnt about the Romans and Celts to create their own shields.



Humanities

We will be studying the Celts and the Romans. We will be plotting events on a timeline, looking at the differences in the way they lived and how it has influenced life today, looking at where they invaded and settled on maps and learning about the different ways we know about the past. During R.E lessons the children will be learning about Sikhism.

Each class follows the Abacus maths planning scheme.



Languages, Literacy and Communication

We will be reading the story of The Iron Man by Ted Hughes and writing setting descriptions, newspaper articles and debates. Whilst studying the Celts and the Romans the children will be writing diary recounts of what life was like as a Celt or a Roman and writing a non-chronological report.

During Welsh lessons we will be learning the key vocabulary for Dillad and how to ask for different items of clothing in various ways and money.

During French lessons we will be learning how to say and write the date, colours, and dislikes and asking for a colour or an object.

Health and Wellbeing

During Happy Minds the children will be learning about their brain and learning to celebrate others and themselves.

We will be looking at citizenship including what is right and wrong, rules, responsibility and making difficult decisions.



Science and Technology

During science lessons the children will be learning about magnetism and materials. In magnetism they will be learning about magnetic and non-magnetic, the dangers, how they are used in toys and games and how they help in everyday life. In materials the children will be learning about natural and man-made, the properties, fair-test investigations and insulation.

During ICT lessons children will continue to build on their knowledge and skills of Google Classroom and other HWB apps such as Adobe. They will also be learning how to use Excel.

In design and technology we will be looking at how to make a talking robot using pneumatics, how to design and improve our work and evaluating what worked well.
