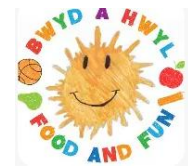
Crusaders Rugby Class H and I have had some fantastic rugby sessions ran by the Crusaders. The sessions have been happening every Friday during this half-term.
